SHARE YOUR COURSE WITH STUDENTS ACROSS EUROPE

Join the FilmEU+ Undergraduate Academy Course Catalogue - an open invitation for teachers to contribute courses and reach new international audiences of undergraduate students.

WHAT IS THE COURSE CATALOGUE?

A shared catalogue of courses offered by 8 European partner institutions in film, media arts, and transversal skills. It gives undergraduate students the opportunity to enroll in courses beyond their home university - and gives you the chance to teach them.

WHAT'S IN IT FOR YOU?

- Seed funding available: up to €1,500 (single institution) or €2,500 (cross-institutional collaboration) (covers assets and services only; not applicable for HR or travel)
- Reach new international students and fresh perspectives
- Explore pedagogical innovation with colleagues across the alliance
- Contribute to automatic credit recognition across FilmEU+ partners
- Travel costs for collaborative course development may be covered

WHAT COUNTS AS A COURSE?

- Existing courses in your own institution you'd like to open to FilmEU+ students
- New courses developed specifically for the catalogue
- Online, hybrid, or on-site - all formats welcome
- Taught in English
- Free for students; admissions managed by the hosting institution

HOW TO GET INVOLVED

1. Submit your course proposal via the online form
2. Proposals are evaluated and selected by the FilmEU+ WP6 work group
3. Selected courses go live in the catalogue for student enrolment

COLLABORATION IS ENCOURAGED

Co-developed courses (two institutions working together) receive higher funding (up to €2,500) and a greater chance of selection. Think about a colleague at another FilmEU+ partner you'd like to team up with.
